3D TRAINING FOR CAMERA PROFESSIONALS

TUESDAY 9 to FRIDAY 13 JANUARY 2012

**Plus up to a further 3 non-consecutive training days
AND WORK EXPERIENCE ON 3D PRODUCTIONS**

This is a fantastic opportunity for experienced camera technicians to learn more about shooting in 3D from some of the best people in the business. But it doesn't stop there; the icing on the cake is to then be able to put what's been learned into practice by working as paid 'trainees' on a variety of 3D productions – to eventually become a Stereo AC and address the current industry shortage. Because that is what getting a place on this course means.

Tutored by leading stereographers, there will be some theoretical discussion which puts 3D into context during the 4 intensive days of the course, but the main focus is very practical - the mechanical use of different 3D rigs: studio, lightweight and side-by-side. People will learn the advantages, practicalities and limitations of each rig; selection and choice of camera and lens systems – depending on the project - as well as monitoring and playback solutions for 3D. People will be told what to look for and how to resolve some of the problems and common issues that arise in 3D stereoscopic shooting.

There are only 6 places available for the course and subsequent work placements so competition is fierce – application forms and CV's will be carefully vetted, after which there may be a series of interviews to attend before selection to attend the course is made.

This flexible industry-led programme is being run by the Guild of British Camera Technicians, tutored by Guild Members with equipment and technical support from Guild Patrons. It is coordinated by Talking Point and funded by the new Skillset Craft and Technical Skills Academy.
